

## Dear Parents and Students.

Parents always ask if there are ways they can help their children over the summer. Below are a few of the things you can do with your children over the summer to help them retain what they learned in second grade and to be ready for third grade. Keep in mind that this is a review of what they already learned in second grade. Please feel free to push your child and go a little further if they are ready.

Remember to read, read, read, all summer! The state has a law that if a third grade student falls far below the reading portion of the AASA (state testing), he/she will need to repeat the third grade. Your child should read at least 20 minutes a day. If you have access to the internet, your child can use Raz-Kids, Imagine Learning, and IXL throughout the summer. If you need help with it, please let me know. The public library and Bookman's also have a great summer reading incentive program to keep your child reading all summer. Your child can also keep a journal over the summer to keep their writing skills up. Below you will find possible learning opportunities for your child to do over the summer to assist them with math. Your child will receive a packet of reading, writing, and math practice that they can complete throughout the summer. Students that return the packet completed at the beginning of the year will receive a prize.
