<u>Please review the following information:</u>

Newsletters: Newsletters will be sent home every Monday in the homework folder. I will provide information on weekly and monthly events in the Newsletter.

Homework: Homework packets will be sent home every Monday and turned in on Fridays. Your child will be provided with a homework folder.

Classroom Discipline Plan: Our classroom uses restorative practice and follows the TUSD code of conduct. A discipline plan form will be available for you and your child to read and sign during the first week of school.

Classroom Environment: It is cold in our room. If your child gets cold quickly, please make sure to provide a sweater to keep in their backpack for daily use.

Snacks: We will need snacks for our children. Since lunch is early in the morning, an afternoon snack is a must. If you can provide snacks for our classroom, that would be appreciated. Snacks include fruit, goldfish crackers, cheez- its, pretzels, graham crackers, granola bars, popcorn, chex mix, etc. Thank you!

School Hours: School begins at 8:35 a.m. and dismisses at 2:45 p.m. (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday) Wednesday dismissal is at 1:45 p.m.

It is especially important that your child be at school and on time every day. Please try to plan appointments for after school as every minute counts. I have attached the district calendar for your records.

Extended Day: Extended day is our afterschool extension where your child can be enrolled for an additional hour and half in an extracurricular activity. The cost is \$100 per child and \$50 for each additional child. All fees are quarterly. If you have any other questions, please contact the office for help at (520) 225-1200.

Lunch: Lunch is available for all students. Please fill out a lunch form located in the cafeteria. These forms help fund our site so please take the time. Students will have 2 options for lunch and all choices will be sack lunches. All home lunches are welcome and suggested, if possible, for the <u>first two weeks of school</u> to help us all adjust to the routine of the cafeteria.

Volunteering: Please be aware that the first four weeks of school are geared toward building relationships between student and teacher. Following that period, I am happy to welcome volunteers in our classroom. Please reach out if you would like to volunteer.

Communication: I will send out ClassDojo information during the first week. This is an app for you and I to stay in close contact. Keep an eye out for more information.

Supplies: Please see the attached supply list.
