### IV. Magnet Update:

Kinder kickoff was a success.

30 families attended and 81% finalized documents

40 seats are available

8 families are left to register

### V. Principal Report

#### A. Budget:

- Title 1 budget cut: 120,000 to 90,000
- Magnet budget remains the same
- District cutting 10% this upcoming year.
- Leadership Meeting resulted in cutting specialist teacher position to keep TA support for every grade level. TA's are critical for school wide interventions
  - Undesignated Fund Balance: 14,000
    - 10,000 to be transferred to extended day, tutoring, La Posada, etc)
    - 4,000 will remain in undesignated funds for 25-26 school year

#### **Motion to approve funding transfer:**

tutoring, La Posada, etc.**

## B. Staffing Changes

- ExEd TA positions were lost. 1 was filled this past month. We are still in the process of looking for another candidate.
