- 3. Decode regularly spelled two-syllable words with long vowels (ex: decide, homework)
- 4. Ask & answer questions using who, what, where, when, why & how to demonstrate understanding of key ideas in a text.

Writing- Write a complete sentence using beginning capitals, spaces, basic correct spelling, periods or question marks. In 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, students should be able to write 12-15 complete sentences focusing on one main idea. © Keep a journal, write about the stories read, write about daily activities, write letters to family

Math- Here are some math skills to practice:

- 1. Read & write numbers to 1,000.
- 2. Fluently add and subtract up to 100 with and without regrouping (carrying & borrowing)
- 3. Tell and write time from analog and digital clocks to the nearest five minutes using a.m/p.m
- 4. Count money with dollar bills, quarters, dimes, nickels, & pennies up to \$20.
- 5. Count within 1,000 & skip count by 2's, 5's, 10's & 100's.
