V. Magnet Report-

A. Recruiting

1. Carrillo is maintaining the school population at 288 students. Next year we expect over 300 students. We are fully integrated at every grade level. Integration meaning keeping Hispanic population to 70% and other at or above 30%. Carrillo is presently offering student positions after the January and February lotteries. If all families accept, we will be at 38% integration.

VI. Principal Report

A. Budget

- a. Budget will remain the same for the school year 2021-2022. All staff will be funded including TA, monitors, librarian, counselor and specialist

B. Survey

- a. Parents are being called daily to complete parent surveys for school opening. Survey ends the 28th of February
 - i. Presently Carrillo's results is as follows:
 1. Remote= 72 In person= 37
- b. Teachers are not sure of where they will be placed as of this moment. District will give more direction in the coming weeks.
 - i. Questions:
 1. Tanisha- Can parents change their mind later? Zepeda yes but they will need to work with the office to complete the change.
 2. Erin- Who will be teaching if the teacher opts out? Zepeda we are not sure because the subs are not picking up jobs.
 3. Erin- Will both groups of learners still receive specialist classes?
Zepeda – We are not sure how we would work it out, but equity is a big question.
- c. Vaccinations
 - i. Teachers are in the process of getting vaccinated, but presently only 50% have been vaccinated.
